Public Health Nurse has requested extra money per hour due to COVID-19. From \$22.55 to \$30.00 per hour. From July 1, 2020 to the end of the year. Total back pay from July 1, 2020 to August 31, 2020 is \$1,303.75 without deductions. Wendy Farley and Penny Reely from the Health Department explained the reason for the request. Penny Reely is the nurse at the Health Department and has been working through the Covid-19 pandemic and has requested a pay raise for all the extra hours she is working. Penny Reely will be working 30 hours per week instead of the 22.55. Randy Dreher questioned if this was just until the end of the year. Wendy Farley stated it would be ongoing. A motion was made by Robert Spence and seconded by Neil Costello and Opposed by Randy Dreher. Motion carried.

a. Jail Issues-Ashley James stated that a special meeting is being held on September 21, 2020 at 6:30 by the Jail committee and they will get back with the Commissioner's and Council once they have a plan.

### XII. New Business

- a. Sheriff-Archive Social Service & Page Freezer Sheriff Mike Phelps went over how social media that the County does has to be recorded to meet the requirements by the State. This needs to be done as soon as possible. Sheriff Phelps stated that they could probably come up with the enough money to pay until the end of the year and Auditor, Amy Tolbert agreed, stating that each office could contribute.
- b. Amended Salary Ordinance- Health Departments, Wendy Farley stated this was for the new Covid-19 testing on grant 8132. This was appropriated in the additional appropriations in the earlier part of the meeting. A motion was made by John Michael Major and seconded by William Brent Bush. All in favor, motion carried.
- c. Resolution Longevity Pay-Amending the 2020 Salary Schedule to include Longevity Pay. Retro active back to January 2020. It will be equally divided amounts on paychecks distributed beginning on October 2, 2020 and through the final paycheck of 2020. Determinations of an employee's year's of service shall be established in accordance with the policies adopted by the Vermillion County Board of Commissioners.
