- I. Call to Order. The Council convened in a regular meeting on June 13, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. in the Commissioner's Courtroom.
- II. Pledge Allegiance to the Flag.
- III. Roll Call. Members present were President Ashley James, William Rennels, Rick Weir, Kelly Summerville, Brent Bush, Martin Brown, Randy Dreher, Auditor Brenda Furry, Deputy Auditor Sheyanne LaMeau, and County Council Attorney, Scott Craig
- IV. Approval of Minutes. A motion was made to approve the meeting minutes from May 9, 2022 by Weir and seconded by Summerville. All in favor, motion carried.
- V. Treasurer's Report. President, James acknowledged receipt of the Treasurer's Report.
- VI. Transfer of Funds (Reporting Only)-

Jimmy Miller Jr. was present to ask that the two new dispatchers also be added to the salary ordinance. A motion was made by

Bush and seconded by Weir to added dispatchers 4 & 5 to the salary ordinance. All in favor, motion carried.

- X. New Business. Weir asks how are people supposed to budget for the next year if the current economics keeps fluctuating with prices. James states that the state usually sends out information on the predictions of prices, so to go off of that.
- XI. Public Comment. There was no public comment.
- XII. Adjourn. A motion was made by Rennels to adjourn the meeting, and it was seconded by Weir. All in favor, meeting adjourned.
