b. Bakertilly – Engagement letter agreement related to services.

This is only being discussed tonight; this is something that may help with future projections of revenue. The SD1 Bill reformed property tax revenue and income tax revenue over the next several years. This is an analysis, local income tax analysis, a county wide parcel by parcel, and then talked about comprehensive financial plan, to be considered. Council will review.

c. Apex- Representative from **Apex Clean Energy** introduced themselves and provided an overview of the company. Apex develops and operates **wind energy**, **solar energy**, **green hydrogen**, and **battery storage** projects across the United States.

Apex has submitted a **permit application** for a solar project in Vermillion County, known as **Brulet's Creek Solar**. The project will be a **200-megawatt solar facility**, with **construction expected to begin in early 2027**. Currently, **47 landowner agreements** have been signed in support of the project.


Economic Impact:

- Estimated \$270 million taxable investment in Vermillion County
- Approximately \$23 million in new property tax revenue over the 30-year life of the project
- Proposed \$5 million economic development payment to the county

Additionally, Apex has proposed a \$200,000 community fund for St. Bernice, providing \$20,000 annually for 30 years to support local community projects.

- XI. Public Comment Chief Deputy Sheriff Chad Hennis- Wanted to inform Council of a grant the Sheriff's office is trying to obtain to purchase more LPR cameras from Homeland Security Terrorist Preparedness Program for the County. The grant is for \$138,600.
