# Vermillion County Council Meeting Agenda/Minutes

Monday, July 13, 2015 6:30 p.m. Commissioners Courtroom, Courthouse, Newport, Indiana

- I. **CALL TO ORDER**: The Vermillion County Council convened in a meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Monday July 13, 2015
- II. ROLL CALL: Members present were President Michael Carty, Randy Dreher, James McLain, Milisa Carty, Jill Wesch, Auditor Phyllis Orman, First Deputy Amy Tolbert and Attorney Don Darnell. Vice-President Michael Costello and William Brent Bush were absent.
- III. **MINUTES**: The meeting minutes from June 8, 2015 were approved n a motion made by Weschand seconded by Dreher. The motion carried unanimously.
- IV. **COMP TIME:** Mike Carty reported that the current liability decreased approximately \$5,000.00 and he thought a majority was from the Highway Department. Dreher asked about the people that were turning in claims for payments of comp time. Michael Carty said he has not heard anything and stated that the Commissioner's would be the ones to approve those payments. He said another issue is that some people on the Comp Time Report do not even qualify for the comp time and that will need to be addressed. He said in regards to the claims, there is nothing they can do until a claim is submitted. Dreher said they need to get it resolved and move on. Michael Carty asked Auditor Orman to break down the Comp Time report to show the overtime accumulated over 40 hours. She said it will take some time to figure up. Darnell questioned whether the comp time that some employees plan on claiming are actually on their time sheet. Michael Carty said that could be an issue. He said if time sheets were signed and approved they cannot go back and change them. Some office holders stated the employees and office holders did not sign time sheets. Auditor Orman explained that in her office each employee keeps their time for the 2 week period, the employee signs it and then she signs off that she agrees with the time submitted. Those figures are then entered in to the State Board of Accounts prescribed form 99A. Tolbert said she would send everyone a copy of what they use.
- V. **COUNTY TREASURER'S MONTHLY REPORT.** Michael Carty acknowledged receipt of the report. He said he would like to see a monthly fund report that also shows investments.
