- I. **CALL TO ORDER**: The Vermillion County Council convened in a meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Monday October 14, 2015

VIII. 2016 BUDGET ADOPTION. Michael Carty noted that the total amount for General Fund is \$7,540,662.00. He said Bob Purlee with Governmental Consulting said they had a growth factor of \$168,745 and the Council agreed they go up to \$250,000.00 if needed. He said currently they are around \$377,000.00. He just wanted to make sure everyone was aware of that. McLain made a motion to approve the 2016 Budget, seconded by Dreher. Carty was opposed. Motion carried. * Amended on 12/7/2015: The Council also reviewed the Solid Waste and Vermillion Township Budgets. There were no comments from the public. Dreher made a motion to accept the Solid Waste Budget, seconded by Wesh. Motion carried. Orman explained that the Vermillion Township has 2 firemen on their board so they cannot vote on their budget because they the fire department gets money from the township. She explained that the township gets money from the tax distribution. Township Trustee Denise Mitchell explained that the \$77,000.00 request is the same as 2014 and 2015. Wesch made a motion to allow, seconded by Ave. Motion carried.
