- I. **Call to Order.** The Council convened in a regular meeting on June 14, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. in the Commissioner's Courtroom.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
- III. Roll Call. Members present were President Ashley James, Vice President Randy Dreher, Neil Costello, Kelly Summerville, Martin Brown, Auditor, Brenda Furry, Chief Deputy Auditor, Annie Wickens, and County Council Attorney, Scott Craig. Rick Weir was late to the meeting. William Brent Bush was not present.
- IV. Approval of Minutes. James acknowledge the May 10, 2021 meeting minutes. A motion was made to approve the May 10, 2021 meeting minutes by Dreher and seconded by Brown. All in favor, motion carried.
- Treasurer's Report. President, James acknowledged receipt of the Trust Indiana report.
- VI. Comp Time Report. President, James acknowledged receipt of the Comp Time Report.
- VII. Transfer of Funds-Approval by Council- None

- XI. Public Comment-Penney Carpenter, requested an update on the Salary Study. James stated that they put a committee together and they are going over the numbers and will reach a decision as soon as possible. It was also stated that the monies would be retro active to 2021. Salary Study Committee is having another meeting on Wednesday, June 16, 2021.
